**SUBJECT:** **Extension Ladder Recall**

Several brands of popular fiberglass extension ladders have an active safety recall in force as of March, 2008. The ladders are **Louisville and Michigan “D” Rung Fiberglass Extension Ladders.**

**The fly section of the ladder may bind without locking.**

If you have a ladder that is described below, the manufacturer asks that you discontinue use and contact them for further information. **Only ladders with manufacture dates/date codes of September 2007 and October 2007 are affected.**

The Louisville ladder model numbers affected are:
